## **Magnificat Center to Offer Spiritual Help for Cancer Patients, Families, Caregivers**

Beginning on August 15, the Magnificat Center, a sponsored ministry of the Sisters of St. Joseph, will begin offering a program of spiritual care for those whose lives have been touched by the disease of cancer. The program will be directed by Dr. Richard Johnson, a nationally known psychologist and spiritual gerontologist from St. Louis, MO, who has developed a tool for identifying an individual's six spiritual strengths and helping them to live out of these strengths. This is not a cure for cancer or any type of faith healing; but in conjunction with medical care, this program provides an opportunity to learn to use the strengths and virtues within ourselves to live in happiness and peace with whatever process the disease of cancer may take in your life. This program is designed specifically for cancer patients, their caregivers and family members and friends who want to learn how to live emotionally and spiritually healthier lives with this illness.

The actual program starts August 15, 2011, however, Dr. Johnson is offering several free informational presentations for the public to learn more about this program. These informational sessions will be held July 25-29 at the Magnificat Center at 3700 E. Lincoln and anyone is welcome to attend these presentations at no charge. 
# FORMATION


